Witneses thereto and ordered to be recorded, and on the motion of an Agent
for obtained a probat thereof or due Form of Law was granted them giving
Security on which she with William Gabell and Samuel Redway her
Securitis entered into and acknowledged their Bond for the due and
faithful performance of the said Will

In the Name of God Amen I William Wilt of the Parish of Saint
anne and County of Albemarle being in perfect Health and sound Memory
Thanks be to Almighty God for the same I do Think fit to constitute and
appoint this my last Will and Testament in Manner and form as
followeth Viz. First I committ my Spirit into the Hands of Almighty
God that first gave it Secondly my Body to the Earth to be buried in a
decent and Christianly Manner In Promise I Give and bequeath
unto my beloved Son Benjamin Wilt a Grey Mare a great Dble one
Bawler Baon one Plate and half of my wearing Cloaths I Give and
bequeath to my Daughter Sarah Cannady one feather Bed and Furniture
and all the Meat and Corn on my Plantation for the use of her and her
Children this ensuing Year Likewise I bind to my said Daughter my
Negro Tom till such time her Husband John Cannady comes in and
takes Care of her another Children as a Husband ought to do In the case
the said Cannady should not return the said Negro to remain in her
Possession during her Natural Life and after to be divided among
my Children except my Son Benjamin Wilt Sarah Cannady and
Agnes Key Item I Give and Bequeath to my Daughter Agnes Key
my Negro fellow Ned all the rest of my Estate Household Furniture
Cattle Horses Hogs etc I desire it may be equally divided among
my Children except Benjamin Wilt Sarah Cannady and Agnes
Key I do appoint my Son John Wilt and Peter Chateen Executors
of this my last Will and Testament revoking all former Wills by me
made as witness Whereof I have put unto my Hand and Seal this
25 Day of April 1754

and Guy Smith his Securities entered into and acknowledged their
Bond for the due and faithful Performance of the said Will.

and County of Albemarle and Colony of Virginia being very sick and unwell
in Body but of perfect Memory and Mind Thanks be given to God therefore
calling to Mind the Mortality of my Body and knowing that it is appointed for
all men once to die do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament which
is to say principally and first of all I give and recommend my Soul to God that
gave it and for my Body I recommend it to the Earth to be buried in a Christian
like and decent Manner at the Discretion of my Executors nothing Doubting
but at the general Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty
Power of God and touching such worldly Goods as wherein it hath pleased God to
bless me in this Life I give and dispose of the same in the following
Manner and form Simplicity is my Will and I do ordain that in the
first place that all my just Debts and funeral Charges be paid and
satisfied Then I Bequeath unto my beloved Wife Jane White whom I
likewise constitute and ordain to be my whole and sole Executrix of this my
last Will and Testament my Plantation & now live upon with all my
moveables and every other Part and Particular of whole Estate excepting
one Shilling Sterling apiece to my four Brothers to wit James White
William White as also one Shilling Sterling to Sister Margaret and do
hereby utterly disallow and revoke and do annull all former Wills and
Testament Legacies and Executors by me any made before this time named
willed and bequeathed ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last
Will and Testament in witness I have set hereto my Hand and Seal the
Year above written signed sealed published pronounced by the said Robert
White as his last Will and Testament in the presence of us the subscribers
