 a full & free mind & full remembrance of mind & full understanding do hereby give and bequeath  
 unto the said John Nicholas (to have) the sum of one hundred pounds in money or  
 the value thereof to be paid to the said John Nicholas at the death of the said William  
 his heirs or assigns forever.
