hereafter named. Item I leave to my loving wife Sarah Tuley during her
Life all my Estate in Land likewise every Negro & more have or shall have
my Death & then at the Death of my said wife Sarah Tuley to be disposed of
hereafter mentioned. Item I give and bequeath to my son James Tuley after
the Death of his mother a negro woman named Abby & a negro Girl named
Lucy I likewise leave to my Grandson John Tuley son of James Tuley a neg-
ro child called Abby. Item I give and bequeath to my son John Tuley after
the Death of his mother the Plantation whereon I live containing one hundred
& Fifty acres I likewise give my said son John Tuley three negroes named
as follows Tony & my son Tony to him and his heirs lawfully begotten & in
Default thereof I give them to be divided Equally between his sons James
James Tuley Arthur Tuley & Charles Tuley & their heirs forever. Item I give
& bequeath to my son Arthur Tuley after the Death of his mother one negro
named Harriah & Jack. Item I

from as follows I bequeath my soul to Almighty God who gave
my body to the ground to be decently buried at the Discretion of my Executors
hereafter named. I Item I Leave to my Loving wife Sarah Tuley during of her
Life all my Estate in Land Likewise every Negro I now have or shall have
my Death & then at the Death of my said wife Sarah Tuley to be disposed of
hereafter mentioned. I Item I Give and Bequeath to my son James Tuley after
the Death of his mother a negro woman named Abby & a negro girl named
Lucy I Likewise Give to my Grandson John Tuley son of James Tuley a ne-
gro child called Abby. I Item I Give and Bequeath to my son John Tuley after
the Death of his mother the Plantation he now lives on containing one hundred
& Fifty acres I Likewise give my said son John Tuley two negroes named
as follows Tony & Amy & to my son and his heirs lawfully Begotten in
Default of such issue there to be divided Equally between his three brothers
James Tuley Arthur Tuley & Charles Tuley & their heirs for and I Item I Give
& Bequeath to my son Arthur Tuley after the Death of his mother a negro
named Harriah Black. I Item I Give and Bequeath to my son Charles
Tuley after the Death of his mother his two children Tony & Amy & I Give and
Bequeath to my son and his heirs lawfully Begotten in Default of such issue
