Libemania County Virginia Wills 1789 1792
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County being sick & weak but of perfect mind & memory, Thanks
be to God, do this Twentieth day of August in the year of our
Redemption one thousand seven hundred & fifty one make & publish
this my last will & Testament in manner & form following.

I Give & Bequeath to my son James Penley all the sum & sums of
money he now stands Indebted to me.

I Give & Bequeath to my son Charles Penley the one moiety of
what real money I have behind me. Likewise I Give unto my
said son to his heirs forever two beds & furniture. my two horses, one
Gray, four head of Cattle viz. one white backed cow one cow &
yearling & one young steer one Cart & furniture & all my stock
of hogs Excepting two sows, the one moiety of my crop of Corn now
in the ground & my crop of Tobacco & all my outstanding Debts
whatsoever. my said son paying my funeral Charges & all my
last Debts. I Give & Bequeath unto my Daughter Sarah Penley
to her heirs forever one cow and the one moiety of my crop of Corn
now standing & all the rest of my Estate Real & personal except what
has been before said & I do hereby give & bequeath unto my

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I heretofore my daughter Sarah Fenley
her three sons and the one majority of my crop & corn.
I have by will the rest of my estate real & personal except such as
has been before excepted & what I shall hereafter except. I give &
bequeath to my son Charles Fenley who heurs forever the one
majority of my orphans ^{that my orphans are not being provided for} and I ordain & appoint my said son Cha-
rles & my friend Samuel Smith joint Executors of this my Last
will & Testament hereby revoking & annulling all former &
other Wills by me made. Witness my hand & the seal of Margaret
Fenley here to this my last Will & Testament set my hand and
affixed my Seal the Day & year above written. In
