she marries she is to have her dinner right alone and at her decease that
dinner to be equally divided amongst my children, their heirs or legal represen
tatives and to them forever.

Fourthly I give and bequeath to my daughter Cynthia Rigby John
Osborne & Dennis Osborne all my property of every nature and kind whatsoever
with this understanding that my son John is to have the shop occupied
by me and all the Black Smiths tools therein or to me belonging, also my
boat and canoe over and above his equal share of my Estate. I give and
bequeath to my Grandson Richard Rigby my small shot gun.

Fifthly I hereby constitute my wife Rachel Osborne as Executrix of this
my last will and testament disowning all and every other appointment
of the same nature or kind heretofore made or caused to be made by me.
