Sealed with our seals and dated this 8 day of December 1817.

The Condition of the above obligation is such That if the above bounden Mary Myers as Guardian of Catharine Myers shall faithfully account with the Orphans Court of Alexandria County as directed by law for the management of the property and Estate of the Orphan under her care; and shall also deliver up the said property agreeably to the order of the said Court or the directions of law and shall in all respects perform the duty of Guardian to the said Catharine Myers according to law then the above obligation shall cease; it shall otherwise remain in full force and virtue in law.
