out of Court.

KNOW ALL MEN by these presents that we Francis Hawke and
William H. Wilmer are held and firmly bound unto Robert Young Esq^r
Judge of the Orphans Court of Alexandria County in the District of Co-
lumbia and his successors in office in the sum of five hundred dollars
lawful money of the United States to the payment whereof well and
truly to be made we bind ourselves our heirs executors and admans
testators jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our
seals and dated this fifth day of May A.D. 1820

The condition of the above obligation is such that if the abov^r bound
men Francis Hawke shall well and truly perform the office of
Administrator of Charles Hawke late of Alexandria County de-
ceased according to law and shall in all respects discharge the
duties of his required by law as administrator of said estate without
any injury or damage to any person interested in the faithful per-
formance of said office then the above obligation shall cease
it shall otherwise remain in full force and virtue in law
