The condition of the above obligation is that if the said Ann White administratrix of the Goods chattels and credits of Thomas White Junr Deceased do make a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the goods chattels and credits of the said Deceased which have or shall come to the hands possession or knowledge of her the said Administratrix or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for her and the same so made do exhibit unto the said Orphans Court when she shall be thereunto required by the said Court. And such goods Chattels and credits do well and truly administer according to Law and further do make a just and true account of all her doings and doing therein when thereto required by the said Court, and all the rest of the said goods chattels and credits which shall be found remaining upon account of the said Administratrix, the same being first examined and allowed by the Judge of the said Court for the time being, shall Deliver and pay unto such persons respectively as are entitled to the same by Law. And if it shall hereafter appear that any last Will and Testament was made by the Deceased and the same be proved in Court and the Executor obtain a certificate of the probate thereof and the said Administratrix do in such case being required render and deliver up her letters of Administration.
