other part of my property they shall think proper for
that purpose.
Secondly I devise the whole of the residue of Estate whether
real personal or mixed to my Aunt Sally Wendell Grif-
fith to dispose of as she may think proper. And
should the claim I have against the Government

as under the Treaty with Great Britain for depredations on property during the late war. be recovered & likewise devise the same to my Aunt Sally W Griffiths
Thirdly I appoint Doctor Robert Murphy of Westmoreland County & Sally W Griffith of Alexandria Executor & executrix of this my will
