

I Richard Libby of the City of Alexandria District of Columbia  
in the fear of God do make this my last will & Testament revoking and over-  
uling any will or Wills heretofore made by me - I give unto the Chil-  
dren of my lately deceased Sister Carne all my property of what kind  
soever to be equally divided among them. They are to be my whole and sole  
Executors and Executrices and I appoint their Father William to be their  
Guardian to see that this my will be carried into compleat and full effect but  
in case of his death I appoint John Sumsdon Matthew Seasmith & Charles  
Slade to be their Guardians and with regard to the undivided real property  
between Mr Carne and myself I will that Mr Carne or in case of his death  
the said John Sumsdon Matthew Seasmith and Charles Slade be at full  
and free liberty to dispose of the same either by sale or an annual quanti-  
ty for the benefit of my Executors & Executrices and I hereby fully authorise  
them to act by the same as they shall think proper And as to Dick  
Senna and Dennis Glazier it is my will that the two former be liberated  
in ten years from the period they were purchased and the child when it  
shall have arrived at the age of twenty four - as witness my hand  
and seal this sixteenth day of November 1804

At a Session of the Orphans Court for the County of Alexandria in the Dis-  
trict of Columbia the sixteenth day of November 1821 this last will and Testa-  
ment of Richard Libby deceased was presented to this Court by Lewis  
Hophins and proved by the oaths of Charles W Knight and William  
Wedderburn to be wholly written and signed by the Testator and admitted  
to be valid. And the said Lewis Hophins (whose wife one of the chil-  
dren of the Testator Sister Carne is named as an Executor) qualified as Exe-  
cutor to said will and gave bond and security according to law where-  
upon Letters Testamentary were granted him

office of Executor of Richard Libby late of Alexandria County deceased  
according to law and shall in all respects discharge the duties of him  
required by law as Executor aforesaid without any injury or damage to  
any person interested in the faithful performance of said office then  
the above obligation shall cease it shall otherwise remain in full  
force and virtue in law

above obligation shall cease it shall otherwise remain in full force and virtue in law
