

I George Salmon of the Town and County of Alexandria in the District of Columbia do make and ordain this to be my last Will and Testament in manner and form following.

Whereas I the said George Salmon served seven years in the Troops raised by the Colony of Virginia in the war between Great Britain and France which commenced in the year 1754 or 1755 as will appear by my discharge under the hands of Adam Stephen Colonel Commandant of Byrds Regiment at which time I was a Sergeant in the said Regiment, by which service I became intitled to a certain portion of Land but have not hitherto made application for it, NOW I do give and devise all my Right, Title and Claim to whatever Lands that service intitles me to, unto Lawrence Hooff Junior his Heirs and Assigns forever. In WITNESS whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and seal this 28. day of March 1806

First I give my Soul to God who gave it. Secondly I give my Body to the grave to be decently Buried, and after funeral expences and just debts are paid, I do hereby appoint my only friend M^r. Levi Pickering as my sole Administrator. Item I give and bequeath to Levi Pickering one House and Lot containing three Acres of Land on Slash Creek One Bed, Bedstead and Bedding—Five Shirts (my wearing apparel) One Dish to my Country land for services from the U. S. Given under my hand and seal in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifteen. Signed in presence of us, May thirty first and year above written
