The condition of the above obligation is that if the said Charles A Brown administrator of the goods, chattels and credits of James Poplar Deceased do make a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the goods chattels and credits of the said Deceased which have or shall come to the hands possession or knowledge of him the said Administrator or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for him and the same so made do exhibit unto the said Orphans Court when he shall be thereto required by the said Court And such goods, chattels and Credits which do well and truly administer according to Law, and further do make a just and true account of all his doings and doing therein when thereto required by the said Court and all the rest of the said Goods chattels and Credits which shall be found remaining upon the account of the said Administrator, the same being first examined and allowed by the Judge of the said Court for the time being, shall pay and deliver to such persons respectively as are entitled to the same by Law And if it shall hereafter appear that any last Will and Testament was made by the Deceased and the same be proved in Court and the Executor obtain a certificate of the probate thereof and the said Administrator in such case being required render and Deliver up his Letters of Administration.
