our heirs executors and administrators jointly and severally
firmly by these Presents sealed with our seals and dated the
twenty fourth day of May 1825.

shall well and truly perform the office of Administrators with
the will annexed of John Tant late of Alexandria County de-
ceased according to law and shall in all respects discharge the
duty of them required by law as Administrators aforesaid with-

performance of said office then the above obligation to be void else
