ourselves our heirs, executors and administrators jointly and
severally firmly by these presents; sealed with our seals &
dated this 1st day of December 1810.

The conditions of the above obligation is such, that
if the said William Henry Washington, Administrator of
the Goods Chattles and credits of John Luke deceased do make a true and
perfect Inventory of all and singular the Goods Chattles and credits of the
said deceased, which have or shall come to the hands, possession or
knowledge of him ^{William Henry Washington or into the} the said hands and possession of any other person
or persons for him or the same so made do exhibit unto the said Orphan
Court when he shall be thereunto required by the said Court, and
such Goods Chattles and credits do well and truly administer according
to law: and further do make a just and true account of all his doings and
doing therein when thereto required by the said Court, and the rest of the
said Goods Chattles and credits which shall be found remaining upon
account of the said administrator, the same being first examined and
allowed by the Judge of the said Court for the time being shall deliver
and pay unto such persons respectively, as are entitled to the same by law
and if it shall hereafter appear that any last Will and Testament was
made by the deceased and the same be proved in Court and then certified
to be a Certificate of the probate thereof and the said W. H. Washington

Washington do in such case being required render and deliver up his letters of administration. Then this obligation to be void, else to remain in full force.
