fully impressed with the certainty of death, and the uncertainty of the  
time thereof, and believing it necessary to arrange, as far as in my pow-  
er lies, all my worldly concerns, do hereby make, publish and declare  
the following, to be my last will and testament. That is to say, I wish  
to return my soul to God who gave it, and my body to the dust, from  
whence it came, to be decently buried at the discretion of my exors  
hereinafter named. And after the payment of all my just debts, and  
funeral charges, I will and bequeath, unto my well beloved mother  
Susannah Slye, all my property of every kind and description real, per-  
sonal and mixed, which I am now in possession of, or may in any way  
be entitled to, wherever the same may be found, for her use and to be  
at her disposal for ever, as she may think proper, and I do hereby  
constitute and appoint my said mother Susannah Slye to be my sole  
Exors, to carry into full effect this my last will and Testament  
hereby revoking, annulling and declaring void, all other former  
wills made by me, and hereby ratifying and confirming this as my  
last will and testament. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto  
set my hand and affixed my Seal this fifth day of October 1819
