

Know all men by these presents that we William Weston John McComb James Sawrason and Henry Payne are held and firmly bound to Robert Young Esquire Judge of the Orphans Court for the County of Alexandria in the District of Columbia and his successors in office in the sum of Eight Thousand Dollars to which pay ment well and truly to be made to the said Judge and his successors in office we and ourselves our heirs Executors and Administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and Dated the 11<sup>th</sup> Day of February 1815

The condition of the above obligation is that if the said William Weston and John McComb Administrators of the goods chattels and Credits of Joseph Thomas Deceased do make a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the goods chattels and credits of the said Deceased which have or shall come to the hands possession or knowledge of them the said Administrators or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for them and the same do make do exhibit unto the said Orphans Court when they shall be therunto required by the said Court. And such goods chattels and Credits do well and truly administer according to Law and further do make a just and true account of all their doings and doing therein when thereto required by the said Court. And all the rest of the said goods chattels and Credits which shall be found remaining upon account of the said Administrators the same being first examined and allowed by the Judge of the said Court for the time being shall Deliver and pay unto such persons respectively as are entitled to the same by Law. And if it shall hereafter appear that any last will and Testament was made by the Deceased and the same be proved in Court and the Executor obtain a Certificate of the probate thereof and the said Administrators do in such case being required render and Deliver up their Letters of Administration Then this obligation to be void else to remain in full force Sealed and Delivered
