The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bound Harrison Bradley as Guardian of George Wendell Ruggely shall faithfully account with the Orphans Court of Alexandria County for the management of the property and Estate of the Orphan under his care and shall also deliver up said property agreeably to the order of said Court or the directions of law and shall in all respects discharge the duty of Guardian to the said Orphan according to law then the above obligation to be void else remain in full force and virtue in law

In the Name of God Amen I James Laurason of the Town and County of Alexandria in the District of Columbia do make my last Will and Testament as follows revoking all others by me heretofore made.

I give the ground with whatever improvements may be thereon, belonging to me agreeable to the specifications in the annexed Platts, No 1 containing one half Acre No 2 and No 2 continued containing one Acre No 3 containing one Acre, only one half of the last mentioned lot is river and No 5 containing to the several persons therein named, or their issue, the Ground designated in Platt No 2. Conferred, must not be taken possession of or any benefit derived therefrom, by the Grantees until after the death of my Wife, but there must be paid unto by my Executors, for and during the period of her life annually and every year the sum of Two hundred and nine Dollars thirty three cents as a maintenance in part, that being the amount for which the Ground Platt No 2 continued is rented at present in season. The lots with James Laurason's heirs name written therein must be equally divided among the rest of my Children, or their issue, my Grand Children surviving no more of said division than that part I have
