widow and relief of Doctor Samuel DoBrooks formerly of the
County of Sligo in the Kingdom of Ireland and late of Prince
George's County in the State of Maryland deceased, being of sound and
dispositional mind and memory but sensible of the uncertainty of this mo-
tional life I do make this my last Will and Testament reciting all other
impressions I give and devise to my daughter Mary Ann Bulaway and
her heirs forever my Farm near the Cee Springs of Charlotte Hall
in Saint Mary's County State of Maryland.

I do give and devise to my three Grand children Mary Willmient
DoButts, Samuel Wally DoButts and Richardette DoButts and
their Heirs forever all my land near Leonardtown in St. Mary's
County State of Maryland containing one thousand acres more or less
being part of the lands devised by my late husband Do by his brother John
DoButts.

I give and devise to my son John Henry DoButts and his heirs
forever the farm purchased by my late husband of Nicholas Lingan
on which I now reside called Mount Wally situated in Prince
George's County State of Maryland

I do give and devise to James Walker attorney at law near Sligo
the Rev'd William Chambers Armstrong formerly of Sligo and Mary Ann
Bulaway all my estate in the said County of Sligo in the Kingdom of Ireland
as bequeathed unto me by my late Husband to hold to them and their assigns
and to the survivor or survivor of them and the Heirs of the survivor forever
upon this trust that they or the survivor or survivor of them or the
Heirs of such survivor shall sell and dispose of the said estate
and divide the money arising from said sale in the following manner
to wit - that is to say one third unto my son John Henry DoButts, one third to
my daughter Mary Ann Bulaway and the other third to my three grand children
in equal proportion.

It is my Will and desire that my Executors shall pay to my Husband
Stephew and wife John and Elizabeth Raaph fifty dollars each during
their natural lives. I constitute and appoint my son John
Henry DoButts and my Son in law John Peyton Bulaway Executors of this
my last Will and Testament and guardians of my three Grand Children
aforesaid. My Executors will recollect that one share in the Marine
Insurance Company of Philadelphia, and one share in the Insurance
Company of Philadelphia belonging to my daughter

Mary Ann Bulaway being her own property but placed in my name the
certificates of which are in my possession. In witness whereof I
have hereunto set my hand and seal this 16th day of January 1826.

And I so hereby divide all the interest and property to which I may be en-
titled under the Will of my deceased brother Richard Etce Wally of London
to my daughter Mary Ann Bulaway, John H. DoButts and to my two Grand
children Samuel Wally DoButts and Richardette DoButts as follows, to Mary
Ann Bulaway one third, to John H. DoButts one third, to Samuel Wally DoButts
one sixth each with benefit of survivorship between the said Samuel Wally
DoButts and Richardette DoButts. In witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and affixed my seal this 5th day of August 1828.
