The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bound Israel Peyton Thompson Ad-
ministrators of the goods, chattels and personal estate of Michael Fleming deceased, do make a true and perfect inventory of all and singular, the Goods, chattels and credits of the said deceased which have or shall come to the hands possession or knowledge of him the said Israel Peyton Thompson or into the hands and possession of any other person or persons for him, and the same so made do exhibit into the said Orphans Court when he shall be thereto required by the said Court: and such Goods, chattels and credits, do well and truly administer according to law; and further do make a just and true account of his actings and doings therein when thereto required by the said Court: and all the rest of the said Goods, chattels and credits which shall be found remaining upon account of the said Administrator the same being first examined and allowed by the Judge of the said Court for the time being shall deliver and pay unto such persons respectively as are entitled to the same by law: and if it shall hereafter appear that any last will and Testament was made by the deceased, and the same be proved in Court and the Executor obtain a certificate of the probate thereof, and the said Israel Peyton
