now of sound mind and disposing memory do make this my last will and Testament
hereby revoking all others

I mpresimis it is my will and desire that all my just debts be paid and
particularly the following to wit. One hundred pounds due Robert Wade with
interest. he lives in the County of Meath near Croppa Kier. Also ninety pounds
due Mr Read son of Edward Read fifty pounds of which has been paid
To Mr McDonald five guineas and to Mr Robert Rogers near Bunsalk twenty
guineas and some other small debts

Secondly I give and bequeath to my nephew Peter Sheron the house and lot
on Cameron Street which I purchased from Jesse Green and also five hundred
dollars I give and bequeath to my nephew Peter Magee two hundred dollars
To my sister Elizabeth late Magee I give and bequeath the sum of two hundred
and fifty dollars to be paid to her at such times and in such sums as my wife
may direct. To John Sheron near Newry in Ireland two thousand dollars
To Martin Dobblyn who has lived in my family long time I give and bequeath
the sum of one thousand dollars. The residue of my estate real personal and
mixed with all my claims rights and dues I give and bequeath to my wife
Eleanor Sheron and her heirs forever provided she remains a widow and unmar-
ried but if she marries again I give to her one third of my personal estate and
I also give and bequeath to her one third of my real estate during her natural
I also appoint Dr John Richards and Hugh Smith of Alexandria the
Executors of this my last will and Testament In Testimony whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and seal this twelfth day of December in the year
of our Lord Eighteen hundred & twenty

Be it remembered that on this thirteenth day of January
1821 before me Alexander Moore Register of Wills for the County of Alexandria
in the District of Columbia came Anthony Charles Cazneau and Thomas Smith
two of the subscribing witnesses to this last will and Testament of Peter Sheron
deceased and proved the same in due form of law and on the same day John Richards
and Hugh Smith the Executors named in this said will qualified themselves and gave
bond and security according to law and Letters Testamentary were granted them

Know all Men by these presents that we John Richards Hugh Smith
James Douglass and Thomas Smith are held and firmly bound unto Robert Young
Esquire Judge of the Orphans Court of Alexandria County in the District of Columbia
and his successors in office in the sum of forty thousand dollars lawful money of the
United States to the payment whereof well and truly to be made we bind ourselves
our heirs executors and administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents
sealed with our seals and dated this thirteenth day of January 1821

The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bounden
John Richards and Hugh Smith shall well and truly perform the office of
Executors of Peter Sheron deceased late of Alexandria County according to law
and shall in all respects discharge the duties of them required by law as Executors aforesaid
said without any injury or damage to any person interested in the faithful perform-
ance of said then the above obligation shall cease it shall otherwise remain in full
force and virtue in law
