Judge of the Orphans Court of Alexandria County in the District of Columbia and his successors in office in the sum of two hundred dollars lawful money of the United States to the payment whereof well and truly to be made we bind ourselves our heirs Executors and Administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated this 12th day of June 1819.

The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bounden Mary Young shall well and truly perform the office of Administrator of Rebecca Young late of Alexandria County dec^d according to law, and shall in all respects discharge the duties of her required by law as Administrator aforesaid without any injury or damages to any person interested in the faithful performance of said Office then the above obligation shall be void else to remain in full force and virtue in law.

I Sarah Ladd widow and one of the Legacies of John J. Ladd late of Alexandria deceased do hereby declare that I will not take or accept the provision made for me by the will of the said John J. Ladd or any part thereof and I do hereby renounce all benefit which I might claim by the said will, reserving to myself my right of dower and my right to distribution under the 25th section of the Statute entitled an act to reduce into one the several acts concerning wills, the distribution of Intestates estates and the duty of Executors and Administrators and other rights which I may have. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 15th day of June in the year 1819.
