The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bounden James Galt as Guardian of Sam Watson shall faithfully account with the Orphans Court of Alexandria County as directed by law for the management of the property and Estate of the Orphan under his care, and shall also deliver up this said agreeably to the order of the said Court or the directions of law, and shall in all respects the duty of Guardian to the said orphan according to law, then the above obligation shall cease it shall otherwise remain in full force and virtue in law
