In the name of God Amen I Sarah Huguley of the County of Alexandria, do make and ordain this to be my last will and Testament, in manner and form following, reaching all others by me heretofore made.

I impune I direct all my just debts and funeral charges to be paid out of the hire of my Slaves hereafter named.

I Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Malinda Huguley one feather bed with furniture, one feather bed without furniture, one bureau, one breakfast table, one long waiter, one dressing glass, one pair brass candle sticks, six pewter plates, one large dish, one tea kettle, one pot and hooks, and three Windsor chairs.

I Item I give and bequeath unto my son George H. Huguley, one feather bed and furniture, one dining table, one large chest, one pair andirons, six pewter plates, one dish, three chairs, one bread waiter, one long pot and one Dutch oven.

I Item I direct my Slaves Dilson and Sarah to be hired out until my son George H. Huguley attains the twenty first year of his age, and the proceeds of their hire to be divided between George and Malinda, George is to have first out of the hire of Slaves three years schooling, after which period the Slaves are to be sold by my Executors hereinafter named, and the money arising from such sale to be equally distributed among my three children Elizabeth Bradley, Malinda and George H. Huguley, and their heirs - but it is my express will and I do order and direct that the said Slaves shall not be sold out of the District of Columbia or State of Virginia.

Lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint Horace Field Executor of this my last will and Testament. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this Twelfth day of

April one thousand eight hundred and nineteen.
