It is my Will and desire that the residue of my property real personal and mixed should be sold and the money therein accruing after my debts shall have been paid be deposited in the Bank of Potomack for the joint and equal use of my two daughters Ruth and Julia Ann to be given to them at such times and in such portions as their necessities may require at the discretion of my executor

7th I do hereby constitute and appoint my friend Frances Hoag guardian of my Daughters Ruth and Julia Ann and lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint Mr Thomas Jacobs of said town and District of Columbia my sole Executor of this my last will and testament.
