Know all Men by these presents that we Samuel Craig William Paton and John Janney are held and firmly bound unto George Gilpin Esquire Judge of the Orphans Court for the County of Alexandria in the District of Columbia ^{and his Successors in Office} in the sum of eight Thousand Dollars to the payment whereof well and truly to be made to the said Judge and his Successors in Office we bind ourselves our heirs, Executors and administrators, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents sealed with our Seals and Dated this twenty first day of June 1803.

The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above Bound Samuel Craig Executor of the last Will and Testament of William Mitchell Deceased do make or cause to be made a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the Goods Chattels and Credits of the said Deceased, which have or shall come to the hands possession or knowledge of the said Samuel Craig or into the hands and possession of any other person or persons for him, and the same so made do exhibit unto the Orphans Court for the County of Alexandria at such times as he shall be thereto required by the said Court, and the same Goods Chattels and Credits and all other the Goods Chattels and Credits of the said Deceased, which at any time hereafter shall come to the hands possession or knowledge of the said Samuel Craig or into the hands and possession of any other person or

persons for him do well and truly administer according to Law, and further do make a just and true Account of his doings and doings therein when thereto required by the said Court, and also shall well and truly pay and Deliver all the Legacies contained and specified in the said last Will and Testament, as far as the said Goods Chattels and Credits will therunto extend and the Law shall charge;

Then this obligation to be void and of none effect else to remain in full force and virtue
