West & Roger West, orphans of Roger West deceased; his Executors and Administrators; do and shall well and truly pay unto the said Orphans, all such Estate and Estates, as now is or hereafter shall come to the hands and possession of the said Guardian; as soon as the said Orphans shall attain lawful age, or when thereto required by the said Court, and shall well and truly save harmless and indemnify the said Judge of the said Court, and his Successors in Office from all Trouble and damage, that shall or may arise in about the said Estate, then this Obligation to be void, else to remain in full force and virtue.
