George Gilpin Esquire Judge of the Orphans Court for the County of Alexan-  
dria in the District of Columbia and his successors in office, in the sum  
of Fifteen hundred dollars, to which payment well and truly to be made  
to the said Judge and his successors we bind ourselves, our heirs, Ex-  
ecutors and administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents  
Sealed with our seals and dated the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of November 1803

The condition of the above obligation is such that if the above  
bound David Wilson Scott administrator of all and singular the  
Goods Chattels and Credits of deceased grantees heretofore done to make  
a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the Goods, Chattels  
and Credits of the said deceased which take at shall come to the  
hands possession a knowledge of the said David Wilson Scott

or into the hands of possession of any other person or persons for him, and the same  
is made to exhibit unto the said Orphans Court when there required by the said  
Court, and the same Goods Chattels and Credits do well and truly administer accor-  
ding to Law, and further do make a just and true account of all his debts  
and doings therein when there required by the said Court, and all the rest of  
the said Goods, Chattels and Credits which shall be found remaining upon  
account of the said Administrator the same being first examined and allowed  
by the Judge of the said Court for the time being shall deliver and pay unto such  
persons respectively as are entitled to the same by Law, and if it shall hereafter  
appear that any last Will and Testament was made by the deceased and the same be  
proved in Court and the Executor obtain a certificate of the probate thereof; and  
the said Administrator do in such case being required by the Court deliver  
up his Letters of Administration, then this obligation to be void also to anxious  
in full face
