The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bound Lewis Deblois Guardian of his children Mary Ann Deblois Eliza Deblois Charlotte Rebecca Deblois Matilda Deblois John Deblois & Dalton Deblois his Executors, and Administrators do and shall well and truly pay unto the said children all such estate and estates as now is or hereafter shall come to the hands or possession of the said Guardian as soon as the said children attain lawful age, or when thereto required by the said Court; And shall save harmless the said Judge, of the said Court, and his successors in office from all trouble and damage that shall or may arise about the said Estate then this obligation to be void and of none effect else to remain in full force and virtue
