

Know all Men by these presents that we Landon Carter and Charles Bennett are held and jointly bound to George Gilpin Esquire Judge of the Orphan Court for the county of Alexandria in the district of Columbia and his successors in office in the sum of Two hundred dollars to which payment well and truly to be made to the said Judge and his successors in Office we bind ourselves our heirs Executors and administrators jointly and severally firmly by this presents Sealed with our seals and dated this 17<sup>th</sup> day of December 1807-

The Condition of the above Obligation is such that if the above bound Landon Carter guardian of Lucinda Gillies (Orphan of James Gillies) his executors and administrators should well and truly pay unto the said Orphan all such estate and estates as now or hereafter shall come to the hands and possession of the said guardian when the said orphan shall attain lawful age or when thereto required by the said Court and also shall well and truly save harmless and indemnify the said Judge of the said Court and his successors in office from all trouble and damage that shall or may arise about the said estate then this obligation to be void Else to remain in full force-
