The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above named William Oley Administrator full and singular the Goods Chattels and Credits of Eugene Shanty deceased do make a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the Goods Chattels and Credits of the said deceased which have or shall come to the hands possession or knowledge of the said William Oley unto the hands and possession of any other person a pecuniary for him and the same so made do exhibit unto the Orphans Court for the County of Alexandria within the time required by the said Court; that the same Goods Chattels and Credits do well and truly administer according to Law, and further do make a just and true account of all his doings and dealings therein when thereto required by the said Court and all the rest of the said Goods, Chattels and Credits which shall be found remaining upon account of the said Administration the same being first examined and allowed by the Judge of the said Court for the time being shall within and pay unto such persons respectively as are entitled to the same by Law, and if it shall hereafter appear that any last Will and Testament was made by the Deceased and the same be proved in Court, and the Executor obtain a Certificate of the probate thereof and the said Administrator do in such case being required by the Court deliver up his Letters of Administration, then this obligation to be void else to remain in full force.
