Know all Men by these presents that the Henry Sngle Daniel M. Clean and John C. Powell are held and firmly bound to George Cyprian Esquire Judge of the Orphans Court for the County of Alexandria in the district of Columbia and his successors in Office in the sum of Two thousand dollars, to the payment whereof with and truly to be made to the said Judge and his successors in Office we bind ourselves our heirs executors and administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated this 3^d day of October 1807.

The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bound Henry Sngle and Daniel M. Clean administrators of the goods, Chattels and credits of William Huber deceased, damages a husband & his personal inventory of all and singular the goods chattels and credits of the said deceased which have or shall come to the hands possession & knowledge of the said Administrators or into the hands and possession of any other persons or persons for them, and the same so made do exhibit unto the Orphans Court for the County of Alexandria when thereto required by the said

said Court and such goods and Chattels and credits do well and truly administer according to law, and further do make a just and true account of their actings and doings therein when thereto required by the said Court, and all the rest of the said goods, Chattels and credits which shall be found remaining upon account of the said administrators the same being first examined and allowed by the said Judge of the said Court for the time being shall deliver and pay unto such persons respectively as are entitled to the same by law. And if it shall hereafter appear that any last will and testament was made by the deceased and the same be proved in Court, and the Executors obtain a certificate of the probate thereof and the said administrators do in such case being required by the Court under up their letters of administration then this obligation to be void else to remain in full force & virtue.
