and Charles McKnight, are held and firmly bound unto
George Gilpin Esquire, Judge of the Orphans Court for the
County of Alexandria, in the District of Columbia, and
his Successors in Office, in the sum of five hundred dollars
To the payment whereof, well and truly to be made to the said
Judge, and his Successors in Office, we bind ourselves, our
Heirs, Executors, and Administrators, jointly and severally,
firmly by these presents - Sealed with our seals, and

Dated the 19th day of July 1809,

The condition of the above obligation is such that if
the above bound Mary Piercy, Executrix of the last Will and
Testament of Henry Piercy deceased, do make a true and per-
fect Inventory of all and singular the goods, Chattels and
Credits, of the said deceased, which have or shall come to
the hands, possession or knowledge of the said Executrix
or into the hands and possession of any other person or
persons for her; and the same so made, do exhibit unto the
Orphans Court, for the County of Alexandria, when thereto
required by the said Court; and the same Goods, Chat-
tels and Credits, and all other the goods chattels and credits
of the said deceased, which at any time after shall come to the
hands possession or knowledge of the said Executrix; or into
the hands and possession of any other person or persons for
her, do well and truly administer according to law; and
further do make a just and true account of all her act-
ings and doings therein, when thereto required by the said
Court; And also shall well and truly pay and deliver
all the Legacies contained and specified in the said last
Will and Testament, as far as the said goods, Chattels and
credits will thereunto extend; and the law shall charge
Then this Obligation to be void, and of none effect, or else to
remain in full force and virtue
