Item, I give and bequeath unto my beloved friend the Reverend Francis Sgnatus Neale of George Town College District of Columbia, all my real and personal property, wheather in Lands, houses, money, goods, Stock or Chattles of every kind to him and his heirs in fee simple for ever, In trust for the sole use and benefit of the Roman Catholic Church of the Town of Alexandria District of Columbia, and for no other purpose whatsoever, but to be laid out for the benefit of said Church as the Trustees of said Church or their successors, may think proper.

Item, I give and make over to my said beloved friend the Rev^d Francis Sgnatus Neale according to the full extent of the Laws of Virginia in the case of bequeathing a house and legitimate title to real and personal property all my right title in to any real, personal and mixed property that I now possess or have a right to, or may possess or have a right to at my death in the City of Alexandria District of Columbia or elsewhere within the United States or any other part or parts of the World to him and his heirs in fee simple forever, In trust for the use and benefit of the said Roman Catholic Church of Alexandria District of Columbia under the direction of the Trustees.

Item I do hereby constitute and appoint my said friend the Rev^d Francis Sgnatus Neale my Sole-Executor of this my last will and Testament. In Witness whereof I here subscribe my name and affix my Seal this

Known all Men by this presents, that we Francis Sgnatus Neale Matthew Robinson and Francis Murphy, are held and bound to George Gilpin Esquire Judge of the Orphans Court for the County of Alexandria in the District of Columbia, and his successors in office in the sum of Six thousand dollars to which payment well and truly to be made to the said Judge and his successors in office, we bind ourselves our Heirs Executors and Administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents Sealed with our Seals and dated the 9th day of October 1810.

The Condition of the above obligation is That if the said Francis Sgnatus Neale Executor of Sgnatus Sunigel deceased, do make a true and perfect inventory of all and singular the goods chattles and credits of the said deceased, which have or shall come to the hands possession or knowledge of the said Executor or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for him, and the same so made do exhibit unto the said Orphans Court at such times as he shall be thereto required by the said Court. And the same given
