The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bound George Washington Hunter Guardian of Sannett Gunnell (Orphan of Presley Gunnell) his Executors and Administrators do and shall well and truly pay unto the said Orphan all such Estate and estates as now is or hereafter shall come to the hands and possession of the said Guardian as soon as the said Orphan shall attain lawful lawful age, or when thereto required by the the said court; and shall well and truly save harmless and indemnify the said Judge of the said Court and his successors in office from all trouble and damage that shall or may arise about the said Estate then this obligation to be void else to remain in full force and virtue
