Will and Testament of George Washington Craik deceased  
do make a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular  
the Goods, Chattels & Credits of the said deceased, which  
have or shall come to the hands, possession or knowledge  
of the said Executrix, or into the hands, and possession of  
any other person or persons for her; and the same so made  
do exhibit unto the Orphans Court for the County of Alexan-  
dria when thereto required by the said Court, and the same  
Goods, Chattels and Credits; and all other the Goods, Chattels,  
and Credits of the said deceased, which at any time after  
shall come to the hands, possession or knowledge of the said  
Executrix, or into the hands, and possession of any other person  
or persons for her; do well and truly administer according  
to Law; and further do make a just and true Account of  
all her doings and doings therein, when thereto required by  
the said Court; and also shall well and truly pay and deli-  
ver all the Legacies contained & specified in the said last Will and
