

Now all Men by these Presents that we Mary Taylor  
John Canson and William Reed are held and firmly bound to George  
Giffin Esquire Judge of the Orphans Court for the County of Alexandria  
in the District of Columbia and his successors in Office the sum of  
Two hundred Dollars to the payment whereof well and truly to be made, we  
bind ourselves and each of us for the whole and in the whole our and each of  
our heirs Executors and Administrators, jointly and severally firmly by these  
presents sealed with our seals and dated this 27<sup>th</sup> day of November  
1804.

The Condition of the above obligation is such that if  
the above bound, Mary Taylor (Guardian of Susanna Taylor her Executrix  
and Administrator) do and shall well and truly pay unto the said Orphan  
all such Estate and Estates as now is or hereafter shall come to the hands of possession  
of the said Guardian as soon as the said Orphan attains lawfull age or when  
she/he required by the said Court, shall well and truly save himself and  
Indemnify the said Judge his Heirs and Successors from all trouble and  
Damage that shall or may arise about the said Estate, then this obligation  
to be void and of no effect else to remain in full force.

mind and memory, but knowing its expedient for me to die, give these Testaments  
and Ordain justly & specially this to be my last Will & Testament in manner  
and form as follows (Signed) Item I give & bequeath unto my Sister Rebecca  
Thomas living in Cecil County in the State of Maryland, and also her the

said Rebecca Thomas's seven Children that is to say David Thomas, Sarah Thomas,  
Christia Thomas, Thomas Thomas, Jesse Thomas, Rachael Thomas and Cathy Thomas,  
also one hundred Pounds of Tickets Master & Co the balance of which I suppose to be  
Eleven hundred dollars or thereabout to be equally divided between my said Sisters  
Rebecca and her seven above named Children. Item I give unto the above Jesse  
Thomas, in addition to his equal part of the above Eleven hundred dollars two land  
Warrants now in the hands of Elizabeth Simpson the one militaria of one hundred  
Acres and the other of Fifty Acres to him and his Heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto Timme Bare (as I believe her to be my Child) my  
House and lot in Elkton in <sup>County</sup> Cecil the State of Maryland to her and her Heirs  
forever, Lastly Iointly constitute and Ordain John Gilpin of <sup>County</sup> Cecil County  
in the State of Maryland the whole sole Executor of this my last will & Testament,  
leaving all others but this to be my last Will and Testament.
