I give unto the above Jesse Thomas, in addition to his Equid part of the above Eleven hundred dollars, two hundred dollars now in the hands of Elizabeth Simpson, the over balance of one hundred Acres and the other of Fifty Acres to him and his Heirs forever.

I give and bequeath unto Timine Bare (as I believe her to be my Child) my Horse and let no Other in Cecil County the State of Maryland to her and her Heirs forever. Lastly I appoint constitute and Ordain John Giffin of Cecil County in the State of Maryland the whole & sole Executor of this my last will & Testament, revoking all others but this to be my last Will and Testament.
