The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bound Jacob Shuck, Frederick Shuck, his Executors and Administrators do and shall well and truly pay unto the said Ophan all such Estate and Estates as now or hereafter shall come to the hands and possession of the said Jacob Shuck, as soon as the said Ophan attains the lawful age or when thereto required by the said Court, shall well and truly have receipt and indemnify the said George Giffen and his Successors from all trouble and damage that shall or may arise about the said Estate then this obligation to be void else to remaine in full force and virtue

The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bound William Curtis and Thomas Swann do make a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the Goods Chattels and Credits of the said deceased, which have or shall come to the hands possession or Intestate of the said William Curtis or into the hands and possession of any other person or persons for him and the same so made do exhibit unto the Ophan Court for the County of Alameda when thereto required by the said Court, and the same Goods Chattels and Credits do well and truly administer according to law, and further do make a just and true account of all his account and doings therein when thereto required by the said Court, and all the rest of the said Goods Chattels and Credits which shall be found remaining upon account of the said Administrators the same being first Examined and allowed by the Judge of the said Court, for the same being shall deliver and pay unto such parties respectively as are entitled to the same by law.

And if it shall hereafter appear that any kind of Will and testament was made by the Deceased and the same be proved as Court, and the Executors claim a Certificate of the probate thereof and the said Administrators do in such case being required by the Court deliver up the
