Know all Men by these presents that We Joseph Crandell John Beyer & John Harper are hold and firmly bound unto George Gilpin Esquire Judge of the Orphans Court for the County of Alexandria in the District of Columbia and his successors in office in the sum of Two thousand dollars to the payment whereof well and truly to be made to the said Judge and his successors in office be bind ourselves our Heirs Executors and Administrators Jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated this 29th day of May 1810

The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bound Joseph Crandell Guardian of Lemuel Crandell orphan of Thomas Crandell deceased his executors & Administrators do and shall well and truly pay and deliver unto the said Orphan all such estate and estate as may or hereafter shall come to the hands & possession of the said Guardian when the said Orphan shall attain lawful age or when thereto required by the said Court, And also shall well ^{and truly} save harmless and indemnify the said Judge of the said Court and his successors in office from all trouble and damage that shall or may arise about the said estate then this obligation to be void else to remain in full force & virtue
