Know all Men by these presents, that Mr John Bright and Andrew Hayes are held and firmly bound unto George Gifford Esquire Judge of the Orphans Court for the County of Alexandria in the District of Columbia and his successors in office in the sum of five hundred dollars to the payment whereof well and truly to be made we bind ourselves, our Heirs Executors Administrators and assigns jointly and severally firmly by these presents, sealed with our seals and dated this 30th day of January 1806 -

The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bound John Bright Guardian of Margaret Skidmore, his Executors and Administrators do and shall well and truly pay unto the said Orphan all such Estate and Estates as now or hereafter shall come to the hands and possession of the said Guardian when the said Orphan shall attain lawful age or when the said Orphan shall be required by the said Orphans Court, and also shall well and truly save harmless and indemnify the Judge of the said Court and his successors in office from all trouble and damage that shall or may arise about the said Estate then this obligation is to be void otherwise it shall remain in full force -
