The Condition of the above Obligation is such that if the above bound Henry Mills Executor of the last Will and Testament of Henry Mills deceased, do make a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the Goods, Chattels and Credits of the said Deceased, which have or shall come to the hands possession or knowledge of the said Henry Mills or into the hands and possession of any other person or persons for him and the same so made do exhibit unto the Orphans Court for the County of Alexandria at such time as shall be thereunto required by the said Court, and the same Goods, Chattels and Credits and all other the Goods, Chattels and Credits of the said Deceased, which at any time after shall come to the hands, possession or knowledge of the said Henry Mills or into the hands and possession of any other person or persons for him, and the same do well and truly administer according to law, and further do make a just and true account of his doings and doings therein when thereto required by the said Court, and also shall well and truly pay and deliver all the legacies contained and specified in the said last Will and Testament as far as the said Goods, Chattels and Credits will thereto extend and the law shall charge; Then this Obligation to be void else to remain in full force and entire.

The Condition of the above Obligation is such that if the above bound Andrew Fleming Administrator of All and singular the Goods, Chattels and Credits of Duncan Knott deceased, do make a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the Goods, Chattels and Credits of the said deceased, which have or shall come to the hands possession or knowledge of the said Andrew Fleming or into the hands and possession of any other person or persons for him, and the same so made do exhibit unto the Orphans Court for the County of Alexandria when thereto required by the said Court, and the same Goods, Chattels and Credits do well and truly administer according to Law, and further do make a just and true account of his doings and doings therein when thereto required by the said Court, and all the rest of the said Goods, Chattels and Credits which shall be found remaining upon account of the said Administrator the same being first examined and allowed by the Judge of the said Court for the time being shall deliver and pay unto such persons respectively as are entitled to the same by law; And if it shall hereafter appear that any last Will and Testament was made by the deceased and the same be proved in Court and the Executor obtain a Certificate of the probate thereof and the said Administrator do in such case being required deliver up his letters of Administration then this Obligation to be void else to remain in full force.
