

And now all these by these presents that Mr. Hugh West, William Lamphire and William Spaton are held and firmly bound unto George Giffen Esquire, Judge of the Orphans Court for the County of Alexandria in the district of Columbia, and his successors in office in the sum of five thousand dollars in the payment whereof well and truly to be made to the said Judge and his successors we bind ourselves our heirs Executors and Administrators jointly and severally, firmly by these presents, sealed with our seals and dated this 14th day of July 1804.

The Condition of the above obligation is such, that if the above bound Hugh West Administrator with a copy of the Will annexed of Francisna Turner deceased do make a cause to be made a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the Goods Chattels and Credits of the said Deceased which have or shall come to the hands possession or knowledge of the said Administrator, write the hands and possession of any other person or persons for him and the same to make do to be held unto the said Orphans Court when there is required by the said Court and the same Goods Chattels and Credits and all other the Goods Chattels and Credits of the said Deceased which at any time after shall come to the hands possession or knowledge of the said Administrator into the hands and possession of any other person or persons for him do well and truly administer according to law and further do make a just and true account of his doings and doings therein when there is required by the said Court, and also shall well and truly pay and deliver all the legacies contained and specified in the said Will and Testament as far as the said Goods Chattels and Credits will thereunto extend and the law shall charge.

Then this obligation to be void and of none effect in case to remain in full force and virtue.
