Cyprian Esquire Judge of the Orphans Court for the County of Alexandria in the District of Columbia and his successors in office in the sum of five hundred dollars to the payment whereof well and truly to be made to the said Judge and his successors in office we have carelessly and his counties and administrators jointly and severally jointly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated this 4th day of June 1807. The Condition of this above obligation is such that if the above bound John Dixon Guardians of Mary Moore his executrix and administrators do and shall well and truly pay unto the said Orphan all such estate and estates as now or hereafter shall come to the hands and possession of the said guardian when the said Orphan shall attain lawful age or when first required by the said Court and also shall well and truly save harmless and indemnify the said Judge of the said Court and his successors in office from all trouble and damage that shall or may arise about the said said estate then this obligation to be void else to remain in full force.

It is also my will and desire that immediately after my decease my executors (herein after named) selling stock in the Potomack Bank in a the manner arising therefrom be also committed to my sister Elizabeth Richards for the use of the saids Elizabeth & Phillippa, but in case my sisters should be dead, it is thine my desire that whatever is remitted shall be equally divided among my surviving relations. Secondly, It is my will and desire that my house and house and lot upon Washington Street in the County of this District of Columbia shall in the course of next summer be sold and the money arising therefrom to be applied to the discharge of my just debts and the remainder to be also remitted to my aforesaid sisters or relations to be divided as before mentioned. Thirdly it is my will and desire that my worthy and beloved friend Ann Lake shall inherit and possess all and singular every part and parcel of my wearing apparel and every part and parcel of my house hold & Kitchen furniture. I leave it is my last will and desire that my highly esteemed friends Andrew Sammons and Richard Wightman will undertake the Executorship & fulfillment of this my last will and testament hereby revoking all former wills by me made.
