Buford are here and jointly Bound to George Giffen Esquire Judge of the Orphans Court for the County of Alexandria and his Successors in office for the Sum of ten thousand Dollars to which payment well and truly is to made to the said Judge and his Successors we Bind ourselves our Heirs Executors and Administrators jointly and severally jointly by these Presents sealed with our seals and dated this 14th day of February 1804 - The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above Bound Hannah Dyson administration of all and singular the Goods Chattels and Credits of Joseph Dyson deceased do make a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the Goods Chattels and Credits of the said Deceased, which have or shall come to the hands possession or knowledge of the said Administration or into the hands and possession of any other person or persons for her, and the same so made do exhibit unto the said Orphans Court when thereto required by the said Court; and the same Goods Chattels and Credits do well and truly administer according to Law and further do make a just and true account of all her doings and doings therein when thereto required by the said Court; and the said Goods Chattels and Credits which shall be found remaining upon account of the said Administration the same being first examined and allowed by the Judge of the said Court for the time being shall deliver and pay unto such persons respectively as are entitled to the same by Law and if it shall hereafter appear that any last Will and Testament was made by the Deceased and the same be proved in Court and the Executor obtain a Certificate of the probate thereof and the said Administration do in such case being required by the Court deliver up her Letters of Administration; then this obligation to be void else to remain in full force. The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above Bound Bernard Bryan Guardian of Thomas Reades his Executors and Administrators do and shall well and truly pay unto the said Orphan all such Estate and Estates as now is or hereafter shall come to the hands or possession of the said Guardian as soon as the said Orphan attains the lawful age or when thereto required by the said Court, shall well and truly save harmless and indemnify the said Judge his Heirs Successors from all trouble and Damage that shall or may arise about the said Estate then this obligation to be void and of none effect else to remain in full force and time.
