The Condition of the above
obligation is such that if the above bound Benjamin Badger
Guardian of Eleanor M. Catecher his executors and
administrators do and shall well and truly pay unto the
said Orphan all such estate and estates as now is or here-
after shall come to the hands and possession of the said
Guardian as soon as the said Orphan shall attain law-
ful age or when thereto required by the said Court; and shall
well and truly save harmless and indemnify the said Judge of
the said court and his successors in Office from all trouble and
damage that shall or may arise about the said estate, then
this Obligation to be void else to remain in full force -
