 and possession of the said William Hodgson as soon as the said Orphans
 Court shall find it just and proper to require by the said Court, shall
 well and truly save harmless the said Judge and his Successors from
 all liability and damages, which shall and may arise about the said Estate
 then this obligation to be void otherwise remains in full force
