Inprimis, it is my Will and Desire that all my just Debts and Funeral Charges be in the first place satisfied and paid - Item I do order and direct that my ^{late and} House in the Town of Alexandria and my lot of Ground at the place commonly called the Spring Garden be sold by Executors herein after named in such manner and upon such Credits as to them shall appear most likely to command a good price - Item I give unto my Sister Martha M. Langlen two fifths of the net proceeds of my said Lots and House, and all other personal Estate after the payment of my Debts and Funeral Charges, to her, her Executors and Administrators -

Item I give unto my Brother James Mitchell one fifth of my said Estate to him his Executors and Administrators - Item I give unto my Brother Thomas Mitchell one fifth of my said Estate to him, his Executors and Administrators - Item I give unto my Sister Jane Robinson one fifth of my said Estate, to her and ^{her} Executors, and Administrators -

Lastly I nominate and appoint my Friends Samuel Craig and Bryan Thompson, Executors of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all former and other Wills by me heretofore made and declaring this, and no other to be my last Will and Testament - In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this Twenty Sixth day of April one thousand Seven hundred and ninety eight -

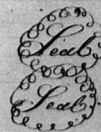
