 will descend from the landed estate of my father Robert
 Kincaid dec'd which interest will not descend until the
 death of Joseph H. Permyer, and out of the monies arising
 therefrom, pay and satisfy such of my just debts as
 shall remain unpaid, out of the perishable part of my
 Estate.

 I give to my wife Katharine Kincaid, all my Estate
 both real and personal, for her own use and comfort
