And on motion of Thomas Karmen one of the executors named in the will of Peter Karmen dec. which was admitted to be true during this Term who appeared in Court and made oath thereto and together with Christopher Karmen on his solemnity entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of \$1000 for obtaining letters of Administration on the said Christopher Karmen with his will aforesaid annexed in due form.

Alleghany County Court January Term 1848

The last will & Testament of Angelina Skiraid dec. was again produced to the Court for probat, and was further proved by the oath of Thomas Mayse one of the subscribing witnesses thereto and the same is order to be recorded. Whereupon William Skan the executor therein named, who appeared in Court refused to take upon himself the burden of the execution thereof, and relinquished his right to John S Skiraid. Whereupon the said John Skiraid made oath thereto, and with William Skan his security entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of \$1000 Conditioned, as the law directs. Certificate is granted in the said decedent's estate with her will aforesaid annexed in due form.

In William Skan a Called Court of Common pleas, began and held, in and for the County of Scioto, at the Court House thereof, in Portsmouth on Friday the fourteenth day of January, in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and forty eight. Present Samuel Small, William Satter and Edward Knauston associate Judges of said Court.

The last will and Testament of John Williams was this day brought before the Court, and was proved by the oath of Nelson Clark and Edward Hamilton two of the witnesses thereto, whose examination were reduced to writing, and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Court, that the said John Williams was at the time of executing said Will, of full age, of sound mind and memory, and not under any restraint, It is ordered that the said Will and proof, so reduced to writing be recorded and then the Court adjourned.
