In the Name of God Amen: I, Susan Presinger widow of the County of Alleghany and State of Virginia being in good health sound mind and disposing Memory do hereby make this my last will and Testament, in manner and form following.

Firstly I give and bequeath to my beloved Son John Presinger the whole of my Estate both real and personal Except as herein after named.

Secondly I give and bequeath to my beloved Daughter Mary Carpenter deceased (That is) To her daughters now living one hundred and fifty dollars to be divided in equal proportions between them in Current Money of Virginia.

Thirdly I give and bequeath to my beloved Son Andrew Presinger Three Hundred Dollars.

Fourthly I give and bequeath to my beloved Sons Joseph and Alexander Presinger each fifty Dollars, the one fifty to be paid by Joseph Presinger to Alexander Presinger out of a Bond I hold on Joseph Presinger the balance to himself.

Fifthly I give and bequeath to my beloved Daughter Elizabeth Chicago Two Hundred and fifty dollars in Current Money of Virginia.

Sixthly I give and bequeath to my beloved Daughter Susan Ross One dollar.

Seventhly I give and bequeath to my beloved Daughter Susan Reed (That is) To her Daughter Polly fifty dollars; and if she is not living to the next oldest daughter.

Eighthly I give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Nancy Callaghan fifty dollars.

Ninthly I give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Sally Wright fifty dollars.

Tenthly I give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Jane Presinger Three Hundred and fifty dollars in Virginia Money, also one Horse, head, to be valued between fifty and seventy Dollars, also six or seven head of cattle, and the same number of sheep, and all her bedding and furniture and Clothing which she now claims, also her Shinning Wheel, Barren, Pot, oven, set Stoves and forks, and plates.

Eleventhly I give and bequeath to my beloved Daughter Sarah Clark Three hundred and fifty dollars in Virginia Money.

Twelfthly I also bequeath my servant Daniel (commonly called Blue) to be set free at the age of thirty one, also a new suit of Cloths, and ten dollars in money, he was Born the fourth day of November in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred
